John Wesley, the founder of the Methodist Way, wrote in his sermon entitled "The Catholic Spirit" that we just need to agree on the essentials of the faith. "If your heart is as my heart...this is enough."

What do you believe that the essentials of your faith are? If you wrote your own creed and listed for you what were the bottom line, most important beliefs, what would you include in that list?

Among the essentials for me are The Shema: <u>Deuteronomy</u> 6: Hear O Israel, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and soul and mind. And you shall teach it to your children..." It is <u>I Corinthians</u> 13: Love is.... It is <u>1 John</u> 4: 20: you cannot love God whom you have not seen, if you do not love your brother whom you have. To me these Words from God tell me about the love the LORD God has for us; they tell me how "love" behaves; and instruct me how big the circle of love is to extend. They explain to me why God created us and explain to me Jesus willingness to die for us on the cross. (Continued on page 2)

What about you? What are your essentials? What is your bottom line about who you are and how you are to organize and live your life? Think about it.

What is the Biblical purpose of a marriage?

Life is all about relationships. Relationships within our families; relationships with our neighbors; relationship at our work place. RELATIONSHIPS. When you consider the purpose for you bonding yourself to one person with whom you build your life, how do you form that relationship? What is its purpose and how does it work? What are the commitments and promises? In February, the United Methodist Church is meeting for a special called convention to try to work out a sticky issue that we have been, quite frankly, dealing with since the 1970's. And the question circles around 'what is the purpose of a marriage?' Jesus does not give us help on this topic. In the scriptural debate about homosexuality, Jesus never speaks. But since people do bat around scripture right and left in this exploration, I was wondering if we would like to explore this together. So, I am offering a Bible Study beginning the second Wednesday in February. It will run from 6:15 to 7: 15. We will consider how the Bible/the Word of God is put together, we will look at the Genesis 1 and 2; we will explore how to discuss differences graciously; we will explore the mandates from the ancient world; we will consider how we put the puzzle together. Understand, the Bible can be organized in many ways. I have seen its words used to prove everything from justification of slavery, to holy war, to child abuse. I have heard arguments on food laws and on how to treat the exposure to blood. I do not intend to take a side in this Bible Study. I do intend to look at both sides from a Biblical foundation and to consider how we 'love' each other as we do so.

So... if you have a bend on the topic, join me. If you are curious what the Bible has to say and what the different words are for homosexuality in the Bible, come and join me. If you are just curious, join me February 13th, 6:15 pm. - Teresa

- February Food Focus

The people in this area of Chesterfield are the poorest in the county including the top two highest percentage free & reduced lunch schools, Bensley and Bellwood.

- A Place of Miracles Café

A Place of Miracles Cafe has moved to the Bellwood Baptist Church,

9138 Quinnford Boulevard (at the corner of Quinnford Boulevard and Willis Road). They are serving hot meals on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 5 - 7 PM. Grocery items are distributed on Friday evenings. We could still use crock pots for distribution to families that visit the Cafe. If you are interested in helping to prepare meals, please see Bill Poole. TUMC volunteers on February 1st and 15th. Jen Walker usually volunteers to prepare meals every Tuesday, if you would like to help her out one week, please see her.
