March Calendar

"Come into God's court with thanksgiving and praise."

Lent is almost here. It is a time of year for us to reflect on our faithfulness to God. He gives to us all year long. He provides us with opportunities and blessings. His spirit upholds us and gets us through.

At this time of year, we consider our faithfulness to God. So I ask you, how are you doing? In particular, I am asking you to review your finances. When you look at your spending habits, where does your money go? How often do you eat out? How much do you spend on personal items like your hair? What hobbies: plays, tools, outings do you support? Write out your budget over several months and see where your money goes.

Next I ask you to look at how much you put into God's house. God asks for 10%. Whether this is before taxes or after, what would the 10% be? And how close to the 10% are you?

Finally, if you are not at the 10%, how can you rearrange your spending so that you can move in the direction of the tithe? I have told you that our budget went up 4%. This is not a lot of money, but it is an increase. Can you increase your giving by 4%. If you are giving \$5 a month, can you increase it to \$9? I started by asking how much you spend on yourself because often, the steps toward faithfulness is found in the odd treats we give to ourselves.

Budgets are not made in a day. Being faithful with our money isn't done in a day either. It is a conscious effort and decision, made over years of decision making.

Please consider taking this year and take steps of faithful discipleship. What is your next step? Make a decision to be faithful and celebrate God's care of you and faithfulness to you.
